Continue to Lauterbrunnen, the picturesque valley of 72 waterfalls, perfect for a quick photo stop before your ascent.</p> <p>Board the train to Jungfrauoch, climbing through lush valleys and winding alpine landscapes to reach the highest railway station in Europe. Spend around two hours at the Top of Europe, admiring the majestic Aletsch Glacier, strolling through the Ice Palace, exploring the Ice Tunnel, and enjoying panoramic views of the Eiger, Mönch, and Jungfrau peaks from the Sphinx Observatory. Don't miss the Alpine Sensation exhibition, showcasing the rich history of the region.</p> <p>After your summit visit, descend via train and cable car to Grindelwald, surrounded by stunning mountain scenery. Grindelwald serves as the final stop, where you can capture last memories of the Alps before boarding the bus for the scenic return to Lucerne, reflecting on an unforgettable day in the heart of the Swiss Alps.</p>
